Candice B & The Light Meter is the indie folk project of Edmonton-based singer-songwriter Candice Bartlett. Drawing inspiration from artists like Fruit Bats, Ricki Lee Jones, and Bon Iver, the music blends warm acoustic textures, layered harmonies, and thoughtful songwriting into a sound that is both intimate and expansive — rooted in themes of nature, connection, and finding light in the world.

Her EP *Golden Hour* is out now on all major streaming platforms. Within two weeks of release, the project **debuted at #9 on the CKUA Top 30 Chart** and was selected for Exclaim!'s The Eh! List, a weekly showcase of the best new Canadian music.

Notable tracks include *Golden Hour*, *Rise*, and *No Problem*.

Bartlett will celebrate the release with an EP showcase at The Aviary on July 16th.
